Provides additional resource information directly related to the strategy	No additional information received	
Provides additional information on the waste collection and disposal options	An issue of bulk waste collection was raised, however it did not provide additional information in the submission	The submission suggested more frequent bulk collections saving the number of tip trips. Indications from other local authorities that provide a more frequent service are that the service is not fully utilised. No change to the Strategy
Indicates a change in or clarifies government legislation, management commitment or management policy	This issue was not addressed in the submission	
Proposes alternative strategies for the safe and sustainable disposal of wastes	This issue was not addressed in the submission	
Indicates omissions, inaccuracies or lack of clarity	The submission highlighted typing errors	Typing errors have been corrected.

The writer of submission 1 will be responded to addressing the issues that were not within the gamut of the assessment criteria.

SUBMISSION 2

CRITERIA	ASSESSMENT	COMMENT
Provides additional resource information directly related to the strategy	Additional information was received	The submission provided a number of comments in relation to disposal options and comments on the discussion paper. These comments will be raised with the Mindarie Regional Council's consultant's currently reporting on secondary waste treatment.
Provides additional information on the waste collection and disposal options	An issue was raised regarding separation at source for recyclables using residents free labour to sort the recyclables.	This issue has been considered in the development of the Strategy, however the cost savings in providing one collection service and sorting at a facility is, on the consultant's figures more efficient.
Indicates a change in or clarifies government legislation, management commitment or management policy	This issue was not addressed in the submission	
Proposes alternative strategies for the safe and sustainable disposal of wastes	The submission raised the risks associated with secondary treatment especially composting siting a number of failures. The preference was for a waste to energy facility.	These issues will be raised with the Mindarie Regional Council consultants currently studying the issue. This does not impact on the strategy, as it is not dependent on the disposal options yet. Once the Mindarie Regional Council determines a direction the Strategy will be reviewed
Indicates omissions, inaccuracies or lack of clarity	The submission claims to have detected error in the discussion paper relating to the production of greenhouse gases	The issue is a lack of clarity rather than errors. This is a life cycle debate and is difficult to quantify an outcome. This issue is one for debate at a higher level than the Strategy and does not impact on it.

The writer of submission 2 will be responded to addressing the issues raised in relation to greenhouse gas production and the outcomes of the discussions with the Mindarie Regional Council's Consultants on the issues of waste disposal technology.
