3. WELCOME CULTURAL DEVELOPMENT CO-ORDINATOR

Cr Kadak welcomed James Boyd as the Cultural Development Coordinator to the Committee.

4. 2001 JOONDALUP FESTIVAL AND SUMMER EVENTS UPDATE

J Boyd advised the Committee of the proposed dates for the Summer Events Program. The Summer Events culminate in the Joondalup Festival 24th & 25th March 2001.

The proposal extends animation to the southern suburbs in the City responding to feedback from residents in the area. It is intended that regular events are conducted in the CBD through January and February 2001.

The Committee noted that a New Year Eve's event would be expensive and result in a considerable reduction in the number of events taking place in the CBD in 2001 compared with 2000. It was felt that this would be inappropriate.

The Joondalup Festival will enhance its community focus with new special projects aimed at more actively involving youth. The special projects include the Worn Out Worn Art Workshop Project (subject to funding applications), the Youth Lounge and extended Festival Parade workshops.

Joondalup stakeholders such as Edith Cowan University, the Joondalup Resort and Arena Joondalup are currently being approached with the possibility of holding umbrella or partnered events in the Festival Program.

5. PROMOTION UPDATE

J Boyd tabled the 2001 Marketing Plan for the Joondalup Festival. Promotion and marketing would remain at the same levels as last year. Cr Hurst raised the possibility of utilising banner poles throughout the City, roadside signage and merchandise opportunities. These would be investigated for the 2001 Program.

It was agreed that the Festival television advert should be reviewed for 2001. Opportunities for free media coverage would also be maximised in 2001.

6. SPONSORSHIP/FUNDING UPDATE

J Boyd presented sponsorship and funding initiatives. In addition to successful funding received in 2000, additional applications for funding have been submitted to the ArtsWA Café Culture Fund for the Summer Concert Series and the Australia Council for the Worn Out Worn Art Workshop Project, as part of the Joondalup Festival. An increased request to Healthway had already been successful.

In 2001 local businesses are being targeted as sponsors, specifically in association with the Street Parade as potential Float Sponsors.

7.1 VIP FUNCTIONS

J Lawton raised the hosting of VIP Functions for the Summer Events and Joondalup Festival. The matter would be discussed further, however a function would be held during the Joondalup Festival with one function during the Summer Concert Series.
