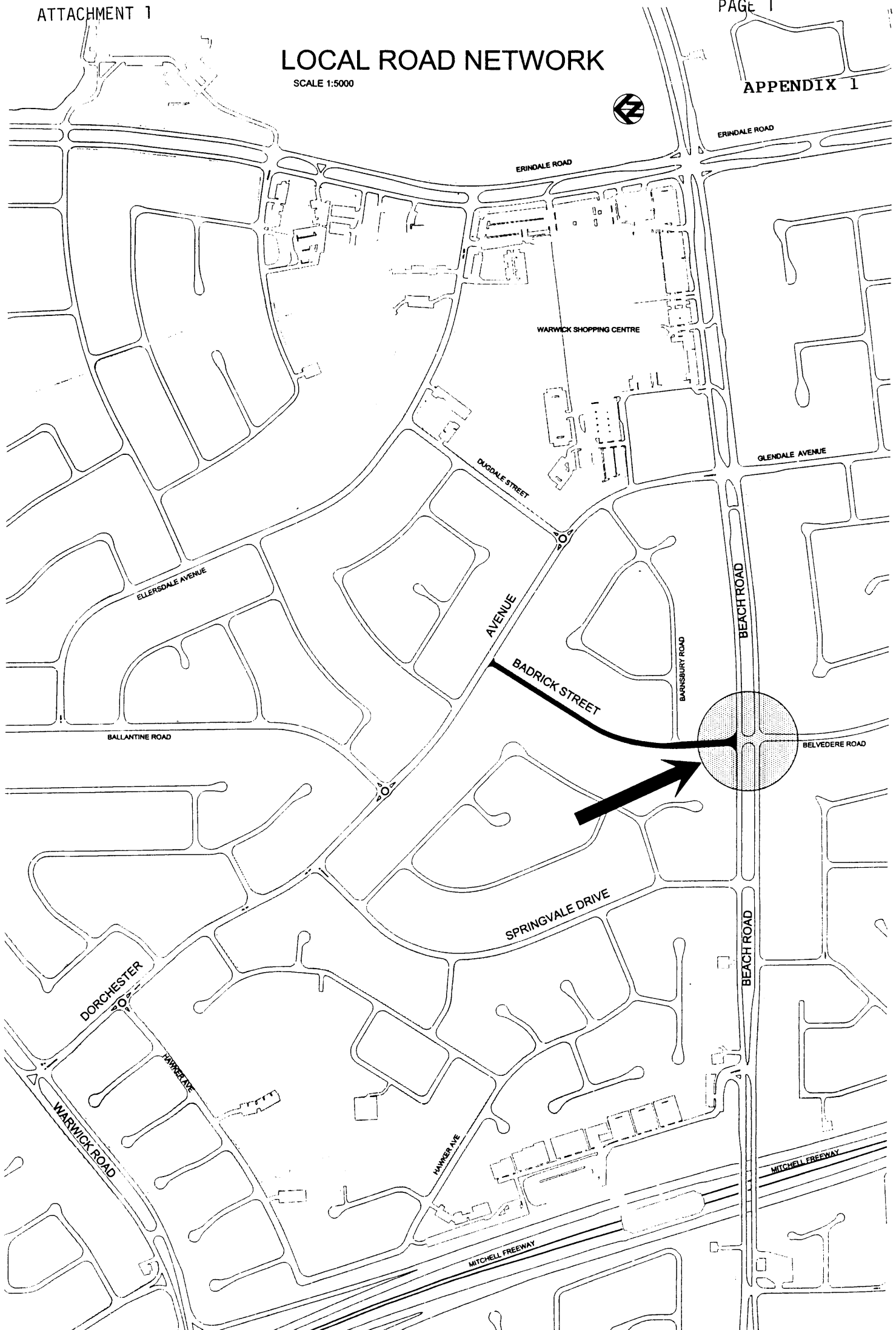


LOCAL ROAD NETWORK


POSSIBLE ROAD CLOSURE - BADRICK STREET, WARWICK

In December 1997, Main Roads WA advised that the District Police Office, Joondalup had highlighted its concerns with the number of vehicle conflicts at the four way intersection of Beach Road, Badrick Street and Belvedere Road. This intersection is the only four way intersection on Beach Road not under traffic signal control and in the past five years there have been fifteen recorded crashes of which eight involved injuries. Main Roads WA have no plans to install traffic signals at this location and it is unlikely that this intersection would ever be ranked as a high enough priority to be considered in the future.

In view of this, the City, in conjunction with the City of Stirling, is currently considering several options to improve safety at this intersection. Main Roads WA considers that the closure of Badrick Street as shown on the attached plan is the most suitable option. In view of the possible impact of a road closure on local residents, the City is seeking your comments on this option prior to the matter being presented in a report to the Joint Commissioners for consideration.

**REQUEST FOR A SPECIAL MEETING OF ELECTORS
IN DORCHESTER HALL, WARWICK**

TO: The Mayor of The City of Joondalup;

- Under section 5.28 of the *Local Government Act 1995*, the electors of the Locality of Warwick, a locality, in the City of Joondalup, whose names, addresses and signatures are set out in the attached list and who comprise 100 electors request that a special meeting of the electors of the district be held in Dorchester Hall in Warwick at 7 p.m. on a weeknight evening convenient to His Worship The Mayor.
- The details of the matter to be discussed at the special meeting are –

To consider the following motions;

2.1. "That this Meeting of Electors calls upon the City of Joondalup to abandon the permanent closure of Badrick St, Warwick and any roundabout proposal for the intersection of Barnsbury Rd and Dorchester Avenue, and take immediate steps to initiate positive action for the installation of traffic lights at the intersection of Beach Road, Belvedere Road and Badrick St, in order to lower Beach Road traffic speeds and safely allow Warwick Electors ingress and egress into Badrick St via Beach Road."

2.2. "Being aware, that the Northern Boundary Line of the City of Stirling and the Southern Boundary Line of the City of Joondalup, is demarked at the Southern Property Lines of the Lots located on the Northern Side of Beach Road, this Meeting condemns the Commissioners appointed by the previous State Government for spending our ratepayer money and proceeding with a closure of a Warwick Street, namely Badrick Street, thereby causing major inconvenience to Warwick Electors in an attempt to solve a perceived problem, that lies wholly within the Municipal Boundary of the City of Stirling."

2.3. "Any other Business in order brought forward by the Electors present at the Electors meeting."
