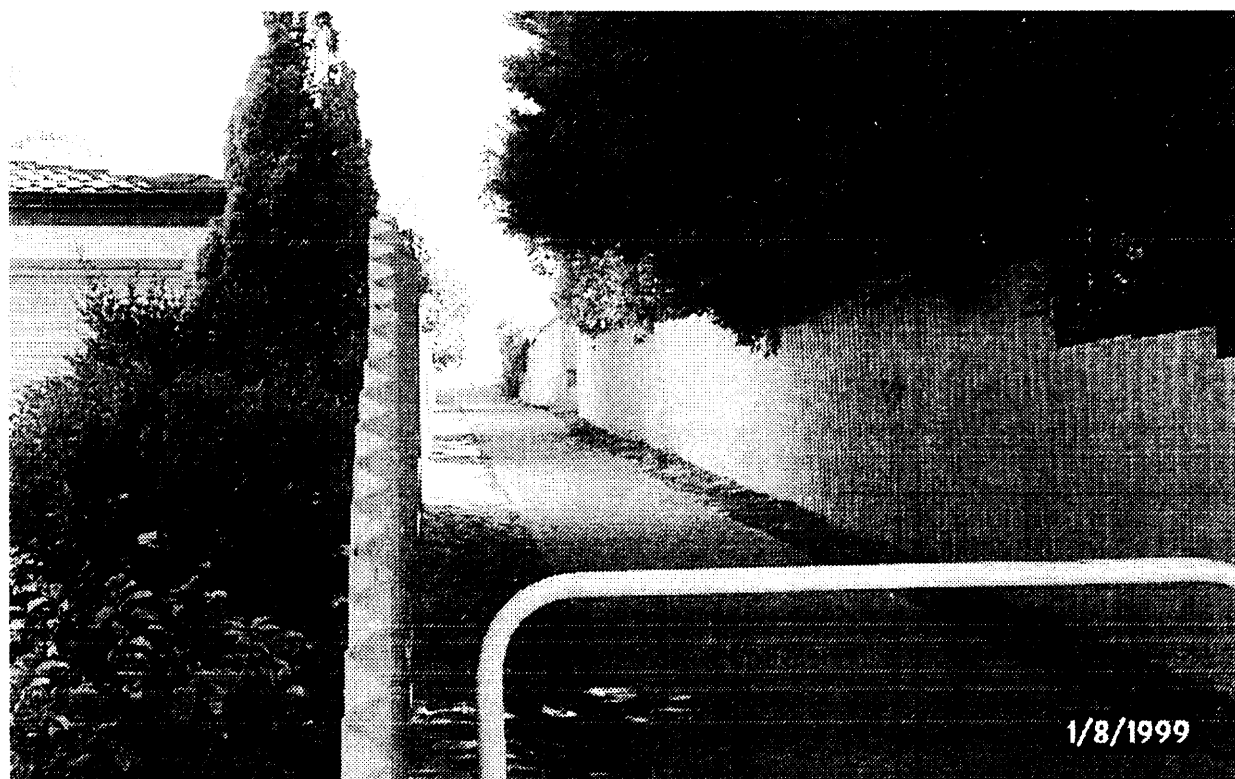

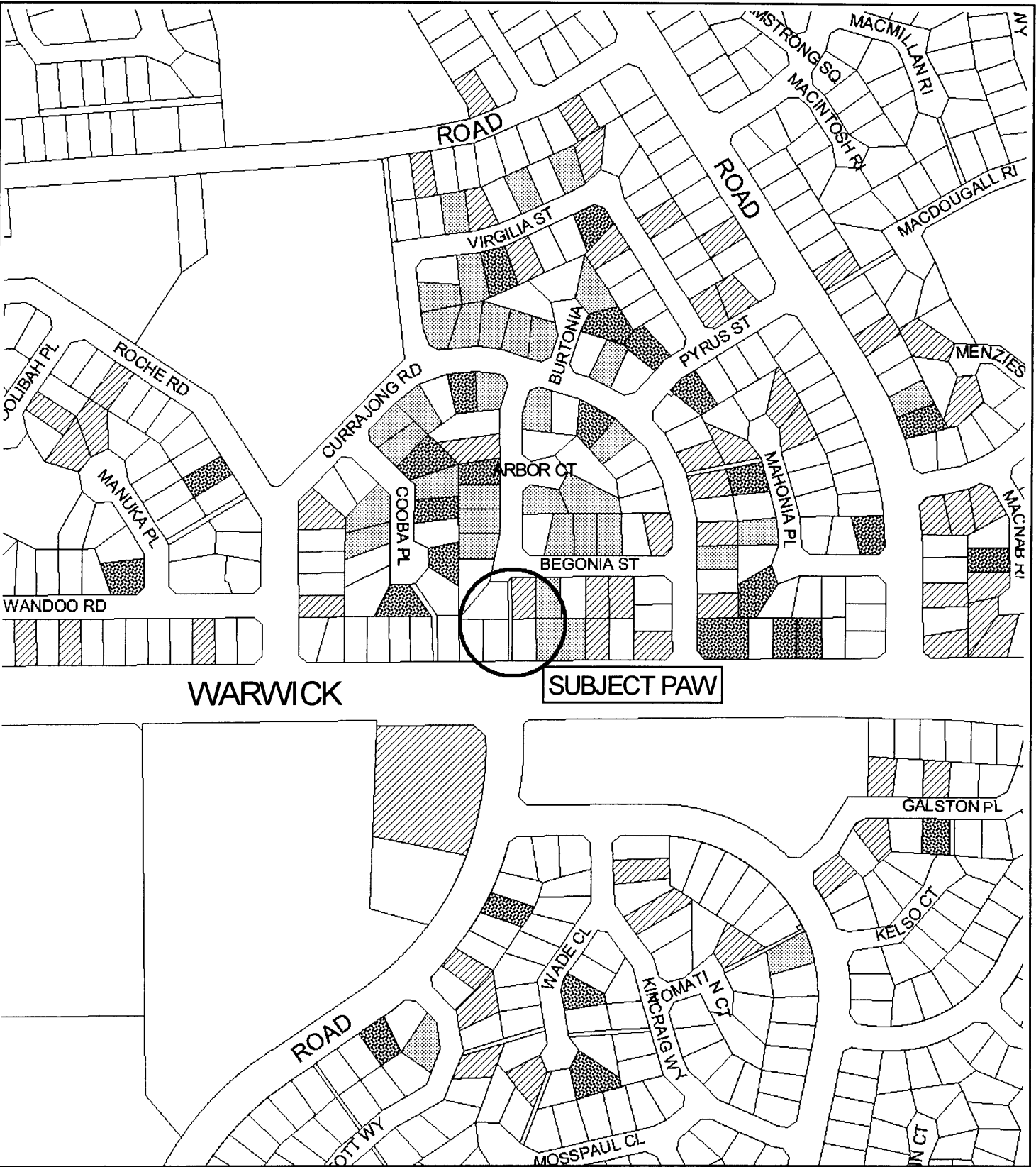






PEDESTRIAN ACCESSWAY BEGONIA STREET TO WARWICK ROAD, DUNCRAIG

An opportunity exists for the PAW to be considered for a lighting trial as part of the City's Safer community Program subject to funds being available. Additional patrols may be requested.

In response to concerns for child safety, the PAW provides a barrier to prevent runaway cyclists from crashing through to Warwick Road. Other streets such as Currajong Road do not have any barriers to prevent this from happening. Furthermore, responsible parents should not allow their children to play unsupervised in the street. 2. Graffiti is a minor problem. In all the time I have used the PAW I have not witnessed any acts of graffiti. No attempt has been made by abutting landowners to clean up the graffiti. 3. There is little evidence of vandalism along the PAW. There is more broken glass along Warwick Road. 4. Closure of the PAW may satisfy the 4 landowners abutting the PAW, but will inconvenience a greater number of households in the street. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Acknowledged. Whilst it is appreciated that some concern for child safety can be validated by having the PAW linked to the road, it is considered the risk would be similar to that expected for all housing in suburban area connected to the road system. 2.
