**2 CONFIRMATION OF MINUTES-MEETING HELD 30 JULY 2001**

**MOVED** Cr Barnett **SECONDED** Cr Mackintosh that the Urban Animal Management Committee recommends to Council that it PARTICIPATES in the Delta Dog Safe™ Programme and LISTS funds of \$7,000 in the 2002/03 draft budget to implement this programme.

**CARRIED****4 URBAN ANIMAL ACTION PLAN-DOGS****Dog Adventure Playground**

It was noted that a location at the Hillarys Dog Beach would be further investigated as a potential site for the proposed Dog Adventure Playground.

Cr Barnett advised that representatives from the Joondalup Dog Training Club are willing to conduct demonstrations on dog obedience once this facility has been established.

### **Discount on Dog Registration**

**MOVED** Cr Barnett **SECONDED** Cr Mackintosh that the Urban Animal Management Committee recommends to Council that it:

- 1     LISTS funds of \$3,000 in the 2002/03 draft budget to provide incentives to dog owners to attend a recognised dog obedience course; and
- 2     LOBBIES the State Government for changes to the Dog Act to enable local governments to provide discounts on dog registrations for dog owners to attend a recognised dog obedience course.
