SIGNING BY THE FORTHCOMING JINAN DELEGATION**

**MEMORANDUM OF FRIENDLY TALKS BETWEEN CITY OF JINAN,
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND CITY OF JOONDALUP, AUSTRALIA**

From September 20, 2001 to September 24, 2001, a friendly delegation headed by John Bombak JP, the Mayor of Joondalup, Australia, paid a visit to City of Jinan, Shandong, China. A friendly discussion was held between Mayor Xie Yutang, City of Jinan and the delegation on the basis of mutual benefit and equality. The memorandum of friendly talks was reached as follows:

1. Actively promote friendly relation between the two cities; strengthen the understanding and friendship and eventually lead to establish friendly city relations at matured time.
2. On the basis of education co-operation, widen the exchanges and co-operation in the areas of science and technology, economy and trade, tourism, etc.
3. Exchange of delegations of government and business are encouraged. The city government will arrange invitations for other side accordingly and make necessary arrangement.
4. The formal communication should be through the Foreign Affairs Office or International Relation Office between the two cities.

**DRAFT AMENDED MEMORANDUM RECOMMENDED FOR SIGNING BY
THE CITY OF JOONDALUP AND THE FORTHCOMING JINAN
DELEGATION**

**MEMORANDUM OF FRIENDLY TALKS BETWEEN THE CITY OF JINAN,
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA AND THE CITY OF JOONDALUP,
AUSTRALIA**

Between 20 September 2001 and 24 September 2001, a friendly delegation led by John Bombak JP, the Mayor of Joondalup, Australia, and including officials from Edith Cowan University, Western Australia paid a visit to City of Jinan, Shandong, China. Cordial discussions were held between Mayor Xie Yutang, City of Jinan and the delegation on the basis of mutual benefit and equality. The Memorandum of Friendly Talks concluded with both parties being supportive of:

1. Actively promoting friendly relation between the two cities and strengthening the understanding and friendship that will, when appropriate, lead to a more formal agreement between the two Cities.
2. Strengthening and deepening education cooperation as the key basis of the relationship with the view to further widening cooperation, when appropriate, in the areas of science and technology, tourism, investment and other business opportunities.
3. Facilitating the exchange of delegations between the two Cities among business and community groups with the arrangement of invitations where this is necessary to the official travel documentation of the party involved.
4. The formal communication being conducted through the Foreign Affairs Office in the City of Jinan and through the Office of the Mayor in the City of Joondalup.
