Definition of Elector:

The Local Government Act 1995 states that an elector may be one of the following:

- *a resident owner or occupier enrolled to vote at State elections;*
- *an owner of rateable property (eg an absentee land owner or an owner of business premises, vacant land or other non-residential property);*
- *an occupier of rateable property (eg a tenant of business premises or other non-residential property)*

Voting:

- *Each elector present at the meeting is entitled to one vote on each matter to be decided, but does not have to vote.*
- *All decisions are to be made by a simple majority vote.*
- *Voting is to be conducted so that no voter's vote is secret.*

Speaking at Electors Meetings

The Standing Orders state that a person who is not an elector may not take any part in any discussion at the meeting, unless the meeting, by a motion so permits, but that person is not entitled to vote.

When addressing the meeting, please use the public microphone and state your name and address for minute taking purposes.
