Notes

For delivery in Zone 4 the supply and delivery price allows for delivery leads of up to 20 kilometres. For any Zone 4 lead in excess of 20 kilometres the delivered price would be increased by 10c per tonne for every kilometre in excess of 20 km.

Quoted delivery costs in the schedule of rates and as above are for material delivered in semi tipper trucks. For delivery in rigid body trucks (6 & 8 wheelers) an extra over rate of \$0.90c tonne would apply.

Discounts will not be allowed for payments made in 14 days.

The charges which are set out in the Schedule of Rates, shall be firm and not subject to variation for labour, fuel, materials, taxes, levies, travel, duties, GST administration expenses, implementation or transport, mobilisation, demobilisation and for all delays normal accepted work practices.
