



## Dear Mr Wilson

Thank you for your recent letter out laying the councils objections. After much study of the proposed location we would like to inform you that a survey we conducted during the peak of summer, mid December to the end of January, we found the only time of full occupancy of the car park was Sunday mornings when the surf club was in progress. The rest of the week between the hours of 9am and 2pm there was a maxium of 52% occupancy of the car park spaces were being utelised. In conjuction with this our proposal stated that from Monday to Friday, (weather permitting) our hours of trading would be approximately 2 - 6.30 pm, these times were found to have the least car spaces being occupied, eg up to 13% occupancy.

In response to the presice location our application stated two locations, the first being on the paved area with your rejections being that a water service meter is located and the fact that we could encourage public stopping on the verge in that location. We fully understand this objection and this is why we put foreward a secondary position which we are open to suggestions on.

In the time we have been surveying the sight it has come to our attention that there is a commercial operator taking up full double car park spaces with his van and trailer with kyacs, calling himself www.bluewater.com

We strongly feel that our presence in the area would be of no detriment to any parking spaces and would become a valued community commodity that the general public would grow to rely on in time.

We have seen a number people operating on verge road sides without a license, we have approched the council in a correct and proffesional manner with what we feel is a sound and necessary proposal.

We would be grateful if you would reconisder our proposal and would be happy for any suggestions you may have in regards to our operation.

We look foreward to a positive response from you in the very near future.
