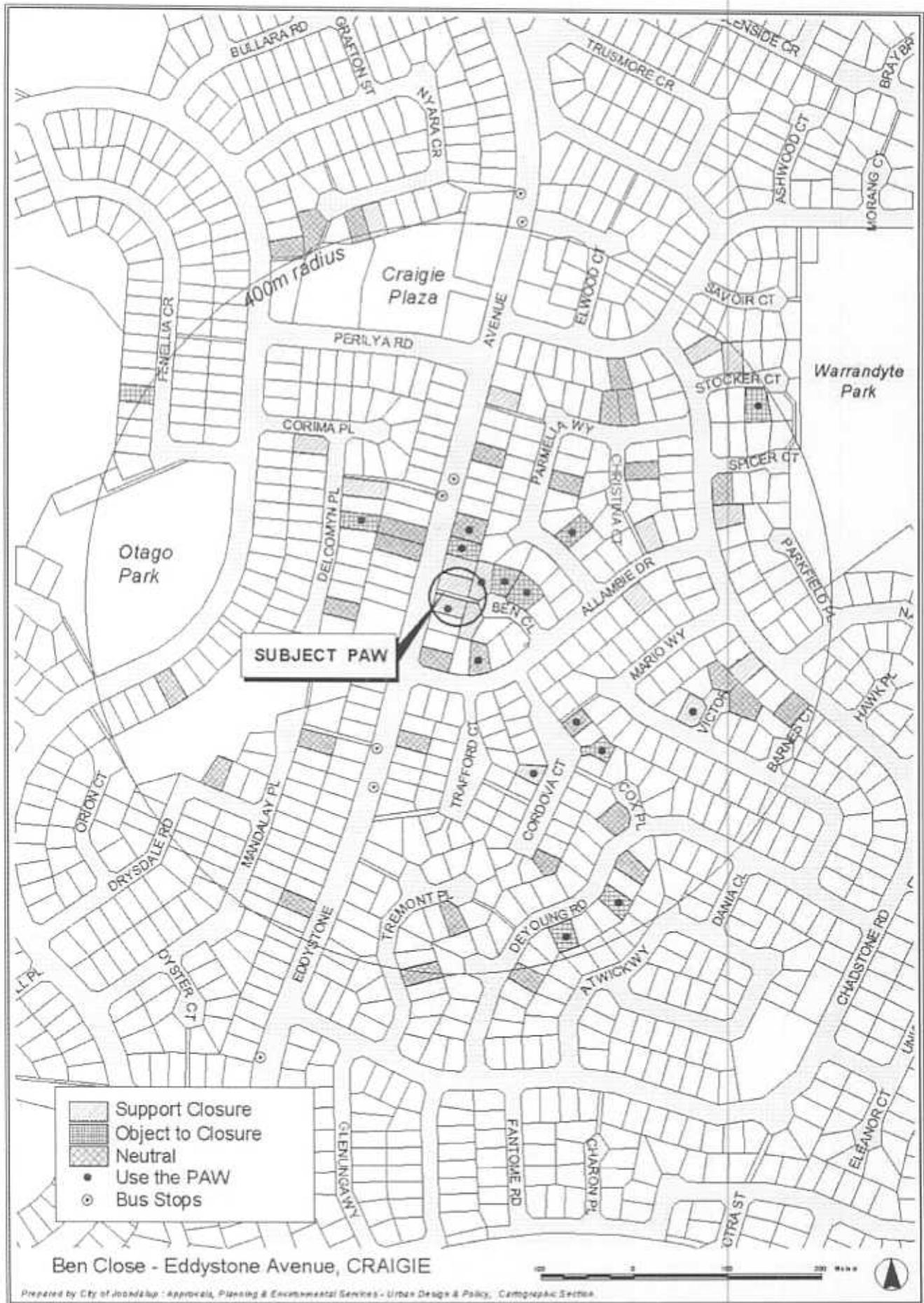




**KEY RESULTS FROM QUESTIONNAIRES RE PROPOSED CLOSURE OF PAW
