Pub 'open in six months'

THE redeveloped Mullaloo Tavern "will be up and running" by February or March next year, says Rennet director Graham Brown.

Rennet, the company that owns the site, is developing a new five-storey project that will include a basement car park, retail and office shops, the redeveloped tavern and penthouse suites.

concrete laid on the ground and first floors.

"We also have some space to let on the ground floor."
