Can you please begin the processes required to facilitate the replacement of the current Toyota Coaster bus used by the Whitford Community, Ratepayers & Recreation Association Inc.

Our previous enquiries in November 2003 (your-ref 14003-339576) with COJ regarding a possible update on the bus confirmed the bus was to be purchasd under COJ and we paid the changeover price. 

In February 2005 I was referred to Andrew Gastor who enquired on our behalf, going thru Govt Treasury and State Supply Departments but as I expected these options weren't valid as concluded on April 1.

We are currently in a financial position to trade-in the current 1995 Toyota Coaster bus and afford an approx \$80,000 changeover.

Can you please advise the exact changeover figures prior to committing us to the deal as I need to confirm the details with our executive committee.

Your assistance with this matter is greatly appreciated.
