

The requirements of Western Power for an easement have been included in the recommendation.
2	Alinta	N/A	Conditional non objection. Portion of the road reserve to be closed contains a distribution mains gas pipe and high pressure gas pipeline. Alinta has no objection on condition that a 10 metre wide easement is put in place to protect Alinta's infrastructure. The easement is to be prepared and lodged in consultation and no cost to Alinta.	Noted. The requirements of Alinta for an easement have been included in the recommendation.
3	Water Corporation	N/A	As the subject land is to be given back to the Water Corporation to incorporate in the existing reserve, no Water Corporation assets will be affected.	Noted.

It is recommended that Water Corporation be requested to not install fencing in this location to maintain visibility to the sign and pedestrian path. 2. It is recommended that a right to access this land be provided for the benefit of the Jehovah's Witnesses Congregation given that this secondary access has been approved by the City.
