# First Schedule - Offences and Modified Penalties

#### LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995

City of Joondalup

Local Government and Public Property Amendment Local Law (No. 2) 2007

Under the powers conferred by the Local Government Act 1995 and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Joondalup resolved on \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ to make the "City of Joondalup Local Government and Public Property Amendment Local Law (No. 2) 2007".

In this local law, the City of Joondalup Local Government and Public Property Local Law as published in the Government Gazette on 18 January 2000 and as amended and published in the Government Gazette on 15 January 2002 is referred to as the principal local law. The principal local law is amended as follows –

### **ARRANGEMENT**

### PART 1-PRELIMINARY

### Title

This title may be referred to as the City of Joondalup Local Government and Public Property Amendment Local Law (No. 2) 2007.

#### Commencement

This local law comes into operation 14 days after the date of its publication in the *Government Gazette*.

## Purpose

The purpose of this local law is to amend various clauses in the *Local Government* and *Public Property Local Law* to prohibit smoking on the City's beaches.

## PART 2 – RESERVES, BEACHES AND BATHING

#### Amendment

The City of Joondalup Local Government and Public Property Local Law 1999 published in the Government Gazette on 18 January 2000 and as amended and published in the Government Gazette on 15 January 2002, is hereby amended in the following manner:

# **Definitions**

Insert the following new definition:

"beach", for the purposes of s.44A, means the area of sandy shoreline from the low-water mark to either the toe of the sand dune or the commencement of vegetation or a man-made structure.
