

# Annual Plan 2007-2008 Progress Report

October to December 2007

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#### INTRODUCTION

The City of Joondalup's Integrated Planning Framework starts with a vision for the City as outlined in the Strategic Plan 2003 – 2008, and includes a series of plans and reporting mechanisms to implement the vision. The Strategic Plan is currently being reviewed for the period 2008-2011.

The framework includes the:

- Strategic Plan which provides broad future strategic directions for the City;
- 20-Year Financial Plan which provides a broad overview of the major projects, programs and resource requirements over the next 4 years and includes 20-year financial projections;
- Annual Plan which contains annual actions to achieve the vision of the Strategic Plan 2003 2008;
- Business Unit Action Plans which contain details of the annual programs, services and activities for each Business Unit;
- Directorate Plans which contain annual priorities for each Directorate; and
- Annual Budget.

The Strategic Plan is developed around four key focus areas within which strategic directions and objectives for the City are articulated. The four key focus areas are:

- Community Wellbeing;
- Caring for the Environment;
- City Development; and
- Organisational Development

The Annual plan contains annual actions to achieve the vision of the Strategic Plan 2003 – 2008. The Annual Plan actions are derived from the Strategic Plan, and address priorities for the City .

The Quarterly Progress Reports against the Annual Plan provide the Council with information on progress against the pre-determined milestones for major projects and programs, and highlight the City's commitment to monitoring and reporting progress against objectives.

## **HIGHLIGHTS – OCTOBER TO DECEMBER 2007 QUARTER**

#### **KEY FOCUS AREA 1 - COMMUNITY WELLBEING**

#### Little Feet Festival

Approximately four and a half thousand people enjoyed the free entertainment and activities at the City of Joondalup Little Feet Festival on Sunday 11 November 2007. The Festival was held for the first time at Craigie Leisure Centre, Craigie, where a range of indoor, outdoor and aquatic activities were held for families with children under twelve years of age.

Highlights of the festival included appearances by Bob the Builder and live shows by dancers and magicians. Other activities included pony rides, an animal farm, and craft and sporting activities.

#### Sister City Relationship - Delegation from Jinan in China

As part of the cultural exchange program a delegation of women from Jinan's Municipal People's Government visited the City of Joondalup from 11 to 14 November 2007. The program for the tour included the following events:

- An official reception at the City with the Mayor, CEO, Directors and Elected Members;
- A visit to Edith Cowan University (ECU) where discussions took place on the possibility of ECU running development programs for women in Jinan;
- A visit to West Coast TAFE and a tour of the Hospitality Centre;
- A visit to Joondalup Hospital and a tour of facilities;
- A visit to Parliament House to meet Judy Hughes MLA; and
- Attendance at a Business Women's Professional Dinner where the delegation gave a keynote speech on women's issues and challenges in modern day China.

## ICLEI – Local Governments for Sustainability – Local Action for Biodiversity (LAB) Project and Overview of the Workshop in Zagreb, Croatia

The Local Action for Biodiversity (LAB) Project is a three year project to develop a network from 20 cities across the world to promote a greater understanding of local government biodiversity issues.

As part of the Project, representatives of the City were required to attend an international workshop, which was hosted by the City of Zagreb, Croatia, from 15-17 October 2007. The CEO and the Manager Strategic Development attended the workshop from 15-17 October 2007 and made a presentation on actions occurring in the areas of biodiversity management in the City of Joondalup.

Some of the key outcomes of the project included:

- Development of a Declaration of Commitment to Biodiversity that will be signed by all participating cities;
- A clear understanding of the different management challenges local governments face in managing biodiversity;
- A clear understanding of the role of local government in turning the tide of biodiversity loss;
- Presentations on the different projects and tools being used across the world to support biodiversity management;
- An agreement to develop action plans by the end of 2008.

Participation in the LAB Project will assist the City to respond to the challenges of environmental management.

## **Environmental Awards for Eco-Business and the Cities for Climate Protection Program**

The City received two environmental awards from the Minister of the Environment, the Hon David Templeman MLA in December 2007.

#### **Eco-Business Program**

The City received an award for its Eco-Business Program which has had significant success in improving the energy efficiency of participating businesses. Evaluation showed that a 9% reduction on annual energy consumption was achieved across all 105 participating businesses, which resulted in a reduction in greenhouse gas emissions of 7,974 tonnes, and annual savings of \$219,100.

#### **Cities for Climate Protection**

A further award was received for participation in the Cities for Climate Protection Program. Through this Program, the City was recognised for demonstrating leadership in taking responsibility for reducing emissions in its own operations and in assisting the community to reduce emissions through awareness-raising activities and key environmental education programs.

#### **KEY FOCUS AREA 3 - CITY DEVELOPMENT**

## **Economic Development Plan**

Council adopted the Economic Development Plan which provides an integrated approach to foster the local economic development of the City of Joondalup. The Plan focuses on four key areas, which include:

- **Industry** Industry development and attraction to maximise local employment;
- People Ensuring that the population has appropriate skills to obtain jobs;
- Infrastructure, Land and Property Ensuring that there are appropriate land and buildings available to accommodate industry growth; and
- Collaboration Collaboration with key stakeholders across the broader north west region.
