It is a medium size company and currently employs 54 full time employees and 4 part time staff. It has an accredited Quality Management System to ISO9001. Sulo MGB Australia is represented in WA via an exclusive agreement with David Gray & Co Pty Ltd. David Gray & Co is the current contracted supplier of MGBs for the City. | It has demonstrated understanding of the required tasks as it has been in the MGB industry for many years. Its Submission stated a number of departures from the requirements of the Request, being a reduced warranty period and payment timeframe. It offered a warranty period of 5 years for the body, lid and/or hinge pins and 3 years for the wheels and axles. Its payment timeframe will be 7 days from date of invoice from each and every delivery of bins and invoicing will be weekly in arrears.
