

LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1995
City of Joondalup
Trading in Public Places Amendment Local Law (No.2) 2009

Under the powers conferred by the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other powers enabling it, the Council of the City of Joondalup resolved on _____ to make the following local law.

1. Citation

This local law may be cited as the *City of Joondalup Trading in Public Places Amendment Local Law (No.2) 2009*.

2. Repeal

The following local law is repealed –

City of Joondalup Local Government and Public Property Amendment Local Law (No.2) 2008, published in the *Government Gazette* No 4 of 10 January 2009.

3. Principal local law

In this local law the *City of Joondalup Trading in Public Places Local Law 1999* published in the *Government Gazette* No 162 of 27 August 1999 and as amended and published in the *Government Gazette* No 205 of 5 December 2008 and the *Government Gazette* No 136 of 10 July 2000 is referred to as the principal local law. The principal local law is amended as follows.

4. Clause 48 amended

(a) The opening words in subclause (1) are deleted and replaced with the following:

“48(1) Where, as a condition of a licence, the licensee is required to provide a public liability insurance policy and keep that insurance policy current for the duration of the licence, it is also a condition of the licence that the City will respond to any actions, suits, claims, damages, losses and expenses caused by or arising from the negligence, or alleged negligence, of the City and the licensee will respond to any suits, claims, damages, losses and expenses caused by or arising from the negligence, or alleged negligence, of the licensee. In such circumstances the licensee shall also –”

(b) Delete subclause (1)(b) and insert “take out a public liability insurance policy for a minimum value of \$10 million or such greater amount as is considered appropriate to the risk involved;”
