Advisory Committee	Terms of Reference
Community Safety and Crime Prevention Advisory Committee	provide advice to the Council on community safety and crime prevention issues; and assist the Council in developing a strategic approach to ensure the safety and well being of the wider community of the City of Joondalup.
Conservation Advisory Committee	make recommendations to Council for the conservation of the City of Joondalup's natural biodiversity; provide strategic input and when requested advice on issues relating to the conservation and management of the City's natural biodiversity; and promote partnerships between Council and the community to protect the City of Joondalup's natural biodiversity as contained within its various natural areas (bushland, wetlands and coastal environment).
Seniors' Interests Advisory Committee	oversee the strategic coordination of all seniors' issues across Council; and provide advice to Council to ensure that the concerns of seniors are adequately represented in the City's planning processes and the strategic directions being developed for older people across the City.
Streetscape Advisory Committee	provide advice to the Council on local streetscape amenity such as street trees, verges, public access ways and medians; and assist the Council with the establishment of themed planting on road reserves to bolster the identity of our neighbourhoods.
Sustainability Advisory Committee	To: recommend to the City of Joondalup Council on policy, advice and appropriate courses of action that promote sustainability, which is: 1) environmentally responsible; 2) socially sound; and 3) economically viable. provide advice to Council on items referred to the Committee from the City of Joondalup administration.
