Presentations

Derek Fletcher Emergency Management Officer City of Joondalup gave an overview on the Metropolitan North and East Recovery Group Partnering Agreement for the Provision of Mutual Aid for Recovery during Emergencies. The Agreement was promulgated in 2004 between the City of Joondalup, the City of Wanneroo, the City of Stirling, the City of Bayswater, the City of Swan, the Town of Bassendean and the Shire of Mundaring.

The Agreement set out Objectives, Expectations, Duration, Amendment, Termination and Withdrawal conditions.

- **Objectives:** to provide mutual aid for recovery management activities during emergencies to parties of this agreement.
- **Expectations:** to provide physical and human resources to initially assist with recovery management during emergencies. Ongoing protracted assistance to be subject to negotiation and agreement.
- To ensure personnel and equipment provided are covered by the providers insurance
- Provider of support will be responsible for costs associated with its legal liability.
- The requestor will be responsible for incidental costs catering, fuel etc.
- The position of chair to be rotated alphabetically through the councils annually
- The group to meet at least once annually
- **Duration and Amendment:** The agreement shall remain in place for 4 years and be reviewed annually
- **Termination:** By mutual agreement of all parties in writing
- **Withdrawal:** Any party may withdraw by giving 3 months notice in writing.

The agreement was last reviewed in 2009/10. The Shire of Kalamunda was added to the agreement and the agreement was signed by Council CEO's on 18 August 2010

John Lane Coordinator WALGA Emergency Management Services advised the following

- A review of the Emergency Management Act 2005 is being carried out and any changes are expected to be mainly cosmetic to reflect changes to Emergency Management Policies, Information sharing and to align with current practice. A draft will be available shortly.
- The Emergency Services Act will soon be promulgated. This act brings together the Bushfires Act, The Fire and Rescue Services Act and the Fire and Emergency Services Act. The Drafting document is currently being written and when completed public consultation will commence. It is expected the process will be completed in 2012
- The Community Justice Standing Committee has carried out a review of Emergency Management in Western Australia and has recommended that the Fire and Emergency Services Authority be the Hazard Management Agency for fire for the State of Western Australia and this was included in the Emergency Management Regulations in November 2010.
- Applications for the AWARE (All West Australians Reducing Emergencies) program are open. The maximum amount available for any one application is \$20,000. Funding for mitigation is no longer available.
- West Australian Local Government Association (WALGA) An Emergency Management Advisory Committee has been formed by WALGA to get a district and state perspective on Emergency Management. The committee consists of a mix of elected members and council staff representing the 14 Emergency Management Districts throughout the State. The committee will meet quarterly to facilitate the promotion of information sharing to the wider emergency management community and to provide feedback on State Emergency Management Policy and legislative change. The group will also make recommendations to the Association to assist the formulation of Association policy on emergency management issues.

General Business

Derek Fletcher presented a draft of the Wanneroo/Joondalup LEMC business Plan for 2011/12 for members to consider and comment on. The plan would be adopted next meeting 5 May 2011

Resmie Greer advised that a workshop to discuss the Risk Register for both Cities would be held at the City of Wanneroo on 22 February commencing at 9.00am. The workshop would include representatives from Wanneroo and Joondalup, WA Police, and FESA.

Resmie Greer also advised that the City of Wanneroo would be holding a desk top exercise for staff on 17 February.

Karen Cagle introduced Ian McDowell the Coordinator of Community Safety for the City of Wanneroo.

Mike Teraci advised that Motor Racing would recommence at Barbagello Raceway in April 2011

John Lane advised that the Department of Environment and Conservation was required to license their mobile food trailers used to provide food to fire fighters during emergencies as a Food Business.

This could have implications for State Emergency Service Units and Council controlled Bushfire Brigades who provide food for their members at emergency situations. He would clarify what are the requirements and advise councils of the result.

The next meeting will be held at the City of Wanneroo on Thursday 5 May 2011 commencing at 10.00am.


