Stage 1 Redevelopment of Joondalup Health Campus

As representative of the landowner (the State of WA), I am pleased to write to you in support of the proposed jointly funded (JHC / State) Child Care Centre at Joondalup Health Campus.

It is understood that child care places will be provided in accordance with the Commonwealth Priority of Access Guidelines, as set out in the *Child Care Benefit (Eligibility of Child Care Services for Approval and Continued Approval) Determination 2000*, with first priority in the allocation of places being given to children of JHC and Department of Health employees.

Remaining places will be offered to the rest of the community, as this is a Commonwealth requirement to be eligible for subsidies.

I am happy to allow this letter to be used in support of a change of the Development Approval conditions that would allow use by non JHC site based persons, on the above basis.



