Ms Linda Horton	Tripartite Cats Laws Group	<i>Animals Local Law 1999</i>	<p>That City of Joondalup recognise FCCWA, COAWA and ANCATS in accordance with the regulations.</p> <p>That members of FCCWA, COAWA and ANCATS who breed cats may apply to the Council for additional cats in order to continue their hobby of breeding cats</p> <p>That members of FCCWA, COAWA and ANCATS who own desexed show cats may apply to the Council for additional cats in order to continue their hobby of breeding cats.</p> <p>That within the Local Laws there is provision for any cat owner who has legitimate reason to apply for additional cats provided that they are not creating a nuisance or health hazard. This would cater for rescue organisations who are fostering and re-homing cats and also for situations where blended families come together, or situations where a family takes on the care of a cat previously owned by an elderly family member who has gone into residential care.</p> <p>That cat numbers are only considered for cats over the age of six months rather than the three months currently specified in the Animals Local Law 1999.</p>	<p>Noted.</p> <p>State legislation has recently been adopted which enables local governments to make local laws in relation to the keeping of cats.</p> <p>These comments will be considered either as part of the development of a new <i>Animals Local Law</i> with provisions relating to cats, or a specific <i>Cats Local Law</i>.</p>
