Upon review and at the City's request, Western Power removed two of the streetlight poles to reduce the number of structures within the central island. The two remaining streetlights are considered appropriate for the operation of the single lane roundabout and have been located outside potential roundabout vehicle conflict points and road clear zones for the 50km/h speed environment. With the focus on road safety, Western Power has also confirmed that the street light poles installed within the central island are classified as frangible and are designed to be impact absorbing.

			The single Norfolk Island Pine has been planted within the central island to highlight the presence of the roundabout especially during night time operations and low visibility situations. The tree planting is consistent with many other roundabouts within the City and has previously been included as part of the Oceanside Promenade concept plan of May 2011. The Norfolk Island Pine is also considered the preferred species for the area and is consistent with similar tree species in Tom Simpson Park. The pine tree foliage is conical in shape and sparse in nature and when mature would limit any negative impact on residents' ocean views.
