<p>A 92 signature petition requesting that Council oppose the establishment of a community garden in Regents Park or Charing Cross Park, Joondalup.</p> <p><b>RCE00489</b></p>	<p>21 February 2012</p>	<p>Complete</p>	<p><b><u>Update as at February 2014</u></b></p> <p>Approval was granted by Council at its meeting held on 17 February 2014 (CJ004-02/14 refers) to establish a community garden in Duncraig as a pilot project. After detailed investigation it is proposed that a community garden not be installed in Regents Park or Charing Cross Park, Joondalup. The lead petitioner will be advised accordingly.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at November 2013</u></b></p> <p>Following assessment of the pilot community garden in Duncraig, an updated proposal will be prepared and a report is likely to be presented to Council in the new year.</p> <p>The Joondalup proposal is still currently being evaluated.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at September 2013</u></b></p> <p>Proposals for pilot community gardens in Duncraig and Joondalup have now been received. The proposals are being evaluated and a report is likely to be presented to the November Council meeting.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at August 2013</u></b></p> <p>Proposals for pilot community gardens in Duncraig and Joondalup are expected to be received in September 2013. Once the proposals are received a report will be prepared for Council consideration that will incorporate all community feedback received to date including this petition.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at May 2013</u></b></p> <p>The City is yet to receive new proposals from the Community Garden Working Group. The Working Group has split to focus on establishing community gardens in both the Joondalup and Duncraig localities. A report will be prepared</p>

The report will incorporate all community feedback received to date including this petition.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at February 2013</u></b></p> <p>The City is yet to receive a new proposal from the Community Garden Working Group.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at September/December 2012</u></b></p> <p>The Community Garden Working Group is in the process of developing a proposal for the potential establishment of a community garden, but is not yet ready to present this to the City.</p> <p>A report dealing with this petition cannot be considered by the Council until the proposal is received from the working group. Following receipt of a proposal, a report will be prepared for Council's consideration which will incorporate all community feedback received to date and will also deal with this petition.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at June 2012</u></b></p> <p>At this time there are no plans to develop a Community Garden in Regents Park or Charing Cross Park, Joondalup. Receipt of this petition will be noted in a further report relating to Community Gardens which is anticipated to be presented to Council in September 2012.</p> <p><b><u>Update as at February 2012</u></b></p> <p>A report on community gardens was presented to Council at its meeting held on 21 February 2012 (CJ007-02/12 refers).</p> <p>Receipt of this petition will be noted as part of any future report presented to Council in relation to the potential establishment of a Community Garden within the City.</p>
