It has the best capacity to meet the City's requirements in terms of the quantity and type of plant, but did not provide the same level of information demonstrating its capacity.	The company demonstrated some experience providing similar services to the City of Melville, BGC Concrete, Millstream Landscapes and Wilmac Plumbing. It provided plant hire services to the City from 2000 to 2014. No specific dates were supplied for its contracts. The references supplied were Wilmac Plumbing, the Cities of Melville and Joondalup.	Dalco Earthmoving demonstrated an understanding of the requirements. It supplies a large range of plant covering the City's requirements, with multiple quantities of many types of equipment.
