1	<p><b>Clause 1.3 – Purpose and effect</b></p> <p>Clause 1.3(3) sets out the intent of the local law. This clause has no legislative effect and can be removed if the City wishes.</p> <p>While the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i> (the Act) requires the purpose and effect to be included in the public notices relating to a proposed local law, there is no requirement to include the purpose and effect in the local law itself.</p>	<p>As per section 3.15 of the <i>Local Government Act 1995</i>, inclusion of the purpose and effect assists with informing residents of the district of the purpose and effect of the local law. This has been a standard practice at the City for its local law framework.</p> <p>The comment is noted and no change is recommended.</p>
2	<p><b>Clause 2.1 - Repeal</b></p> <p>The City should ensure that citations reflect the titles as they appear in the <i>Government Gazette</i> and the citations should be italicised. An example for the City's consideration is:</p> <p>“Bushfire Prevention and Control Local Law 1998” should be replaced with “<i>City of Joondalup Bushfire Prevention and Control Local Law 1998</i>”.</p> <p>It is further suggested that paragraphs (d) and (e) be deleted as section 33 of the <i>Interpretation Act 1984</i> provides that when a local law is repealed, the repeal will also apply to all amendments of the original local law. The amendment clauses referred to in paragraphs (d) and (e) have been previously repealed by the repeal of the primary local law.</p>	<p>Supported. Clause 2.1 amended as suggested.</p>
3	<p><b>Minor edits</b></p> <p><b>Clause 2.1(a) to (c)</b> Insert “on” after “<i>Government Gazette</i>”.</p>	<p>Supported. Clause 2.1 amended as suggested.</p>

# **Repeal Local Law 2017**

Under the powers conferred on it by the *Local Government Act 1995* and under all other enabling powers, the Council of the City of Joondalup resolved on **[insert date]** to make the following local law.

## **Part 1 - Preliminary**

### **1.1 Citation**

This local law may be cited as the *City of Joondalup Repeal Local Law 2017*.

### **1.2 Commencement**

This local law commences 14 days after the day on which it is published in the *Government Gazette*.

### **1.3 Purpose and effect**

- (1) The purpose of this local law is to repeal those local laws made obsolete by new legislation or considered no longer relevant within the City of Joondalup.
- (2) The effect of this local law is to repeal obsolete or outdated local laws within the City of Joondalup.

### **1.4 Application**

This local law applies throughout the district.

## **Part 2 - Repeal**

### **2.1 Repeal of local laws**

The following local laws are repealed on the day that this local law comes into operation –

- (a) *City of Joondalup Bushfire Prevention and Control Local Law 1998* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 8 January 1999;
- (b) *City of Joondalup Extractive Industries Local Law 1998* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 8 March 1999; and
- (c) *City of Joondalup Signs Local Law 1999* as published in the *Government Gazette* on 27 August 1999.
