It provides 24/7 call-out and additional trained staff can be made available. It operates with a quality management system accredited to ISO9001 and has a safety policy in place. A copy of its job safety analysis (JSA) for Sydney York Street was supplied. It stated it has not had any accident or safety issue since 1983.	It did not submit sufficient information demonstrating experience providing similar services. It outlined the company's 36 years of development and history and experience though its involvement in Australian equipment and software design, manufacture and support was mainly related to car park systems. Its Submission did not include any examples of works or similar services relevant to the City's requirement.	It did not demonstrate its understanding of the required tasks. It merely stated the company holds stock allowing rebuilding of any equipment and machine, that the items quoted would be made available ex stock Burswood and quantity of stock to be equivalent to six months of supplies.
