Their roles, qualifications, training and relevant experience in irrigation control systems were provided, most showing demonstrated training. Staff are available 24 hours a day and after-hours contact numbers were supplied. The company has the ability to source more personnel if required. A detailed list of plant and equipment was included. It operates its own quality management systems modelled on the National Electrical Contractors Association systems and included extensive health safety and quality management manuals and policies.	It demonstrated extensive experience in providing similar services for local governments and private organisations. It is the incumbent for City's Irrigation Electrical Services Contract, 024/18, delivering similar works to the City. Similar works undertaken for other local governments include the supply, installation and maintenance of irrigation electrical infrastructure for the Cities of Wanneroo, Melville, Belmont, Victoria Park, Swan and Subiaco. Contract dates, outcomes and referee contacts were provided.	The company demonstrated a thorough understanding of required tasks by submitting a comprehensive methodology, outlining key tasks, from lodgement of jobs to completion of the work, through its ServiceM8 management software. It operates a job management system which provides real time data on appointments, work schedules, work progress, images, circuit diagrams, job priority and safety forms. It provided a standard timeline for new or replacement irrigation cubicles and maintenance works.	It operates a fully serviced workshop based in Joondalup and utilises local suppliers to source parts, materials and equipment.
